Presentation #1: Meeting Policies

Discussion:

- For most, first ever council meeting
- Email cro@macengsociety.ca for any questions!
- Council meetings run once every 2 weeks
 - In a term, 6 meetings
 - Get everyone availability, will try out best even through covid to get the best time for everyone
 - Usually there are a lot of people on council
 - Two types of positions: voting (elected positions) and non voting positions (appointed positions)
 - Quorum: $\frac{2}{3}$ of voting positions at council meeting is required to do any business (ie. pass motions etc.)
 - Mandatory for all MES voting positions to attend council meetings
 - If you can't make a meeting, must email Admin and CC the CRO to let us know
 - Must have an approved absence (illness, class, midterm, representative for MES somewhere else)
 - Proxy: if you aren't able to make a meeting, appoint someone to vote in your place, they can vote on your behalf
 - Can be any full time MES member (ex. Dep rep can ask someone from that department to proxy, must know be related to position)
- Hand gestures: Rogart Rules (on the website, on the policy manual)
 - New Business → Index Finger (use 1 in chat)
 - Bringing up a new point
 - Direct Response to what is being said → Index and Middle finger
 - Asking for Clarification → Pinky finger (use 2 in chat)
 - Must be a quick one-line answer
 - Aras will send this out to all of council (use 3 in chat)
- To make a motion, there is a motion template on the policy manual (title, motioned by, spirit, whereas statement - what will happen after resolved, BRIT - indicates resolution of the motion)
- Will be using google meet for the year
 - Secure and everyone has access
 - Will send it to your calendars, link will be on there
 - Only for meeting, if you want to follow up with someone personally please use Slack!!!!

Presentation #2: Policy Changes

Presented by: Alex Moica

Discussion:

- Aras, Alex and Dziagus have been working and refining the current policy
- Policy manual was created 60 years ago, never actually had a group of people to go over it
 - Kind of a mess, contradicts itself etc
 - Can't work with something this convoluted
- Changed the contents to reflect how the MES currently is
- Why should you care?
 - Money: MES has a lot of money paid for by students, need to ensure that we are benign governed as best way possible
- Motions will come later to decide on these changes, constitution will change at SAGM
- At Fall kick off, will re-present all of the changes and the meeting after, will vote on all the changes
- Colors show suggestion changes, will email the doc to everyone to read over
- Major Changes:
 - Adding ibiomed to voting position
 - Removing appointed positions, adding to bylaws
 - CRO can make constitution changes can make grammatical changes
 - Split up into two sections: constitutions and bylaws
 - Bylaws are a recognized document in the constitutions
 - Constitution changes go through SAGM
 - Policy manual changes through motions
- Bylaws process will stay the same
- Faster to update the policy manual and spend more time on meaningful discussion
- Execs can make policy manual changes by majority vote with letting council know, council can overrule
- Maclab is being removed from policy manual and making it it's own governing documents

- Policy Manual:
 - Change the website to be under the DDomain of social media and website coordinators and not IT
 - MES rental equipment has been consolidated under one section instead of multiple
 - Gotten rid of MES Test Bank
 - Maclab section removed (it's own document)
 - Added financial need exemption for red suits
 - Changed Rogart rules of talking updated
 - Policy manual holds a bunch of Appendices and changes have been updated on the documents
 - Added an MES office use contract - please read!

 - But university uses the money taken in as a lump sum and distribute as university sees fit
 - Kind of out of our control
 - Conversation is still going on but as of now, it's is a no

- Have lowered the MES fee to try and offset
- Proctoring softwares?
 - Motions that Approves the use of proctoring softwares
 - Profs have the right to use a software, piloting has been happening in the summer
 - Still waiting to choose which software, but it will be a universal software for all of the university
 - Approval to use the software, not a requirement, up to the prof to use or not use a proctoring software
 - Concerns about invasion of privacy have been talked about
 - University have created a task force to choose a software that chooses
 - Use of software will be indicated in syllabus
 - Can drop the course and wait till in person classes to take it
 - There are a couple exceptions but it is pretty rare
 - MES stance is anti-proctoring software
 - Advocating for other means of authenticity instead of ripping open students' computers
- Will we have to pay for the software?
 - Some students have had to buy a camera
 - There may be possibilities of having to buy the software
 - MES will advocate for it to be apart of tuition
- Is there any student involvement in choosing a software, who is involved in the task force?
 - Did not go into detail about who is on the task force
 - As of now, don't think there is any perspective of the student of the force
- PSA: can just your phone for meetings but will we be allowed for proctoring software
 - Not sure how this works with the software though
 - One instance: otterlock requires webcam to be connected to computer
- Any discussion on if there has been a glitch when using the software?
 - Things do happen, profs are expected to expect that and must have protocols in place to address that
 - Probably going to be some sort of instructions given by the prof if anything happens to ensure authenticity
